**Dr. Gail Bolan** earned her medical degree from Dartmouth Medical School in Hanover, New Hampshire. She completed her training in internal medicine at the University of Virginia, Charlottesville, and subspecialty training in infectious diseases at Tufts New England Medical Center in Boston and Stanford Medical Center.

Dr. Bolan served as the Director of the San Francisco City and County STD Prevention and Control Program and as Medical Director of the City Clinic, the San Francisco STD Clinic, from 1987 to 1997. She is the Chief of the STD Control Branch of the California Department of Public Health, an Assistant Clinical Professor of Medicine at the University of California, San Francisco and since 1988 she has directed the California STD/HIV Prevention Training Center.

Dr. Bolan was Chair of the National Coalition of STD Directors (NCSDD) and serves on several national, regional and state advisory groups, including the CDC HIV/STD Prevention Advisory Committee. She has published extensively in the field of STD epidemiology and Public health, with over 100 articles in peer-reviewed journals.
